# March Mini-Camp a Hit

Last month Pickleball Zone Bend hosted a mini bootcamp for 2.5 players looking to earn a <u>local-to-Bend-only</u> 3.0 rating.

Coaches from Widgi Creek, Pickleball Zone Bend, and Bend Pickleball Club together provided players two hours of training and round robin play to improve their games and rating. The first hour focused on skills development where each teacher led a group drill; each of four drills focused on an important aspect of pickleball. The second hour was a 5-player round robin modeled after our CORE (Central Oregon Rating Evaluation) program. The four teachers involved assessed players throughout the bootcamp and afterwards met with assistants to discuss how each player fared. It was a huge success.

The Club will be offering several similar bootcamp training sessions at Pine Nursery Park. Upcoming dates and times will be announced.

As for CORE, testing procedures have been proceeding very well. Widgi Creek and Pickleball Zone Bend have been testing their members as well as our own, resulting in numerous rating increases. The Club will start testing members once our 2022 summer season gets underway, most likely in May.

#### Membership Stats-to-Date

As you'll recall, Club membership was capped last fall at 850 members. We currently have just under 900 active members with 23 members in renewal phase. Our waitlist has grown to 351. As a result, we have eliminated one-month guest memberships until our cap is reached. However, each member may still request up to two permanent guest passes for use by visiting friends and family.

<u>Important</u>: To safeguard the optimum use of our courts, we remind every member to wear their name tag while playing at Pine Nursery Park during Club hours.

## Ahoy, Captains!

Our 2022 spring playing season opened on April 4.

- Organized play, including both round robin (RR) play for 3.5 skill level players and skill level play for all other levels is scheduled on Mon/Wed/Fri, 10:00am-12:00pm. Note that a session has been added for 4.5+ skill level play on Court 6 on these same days.
- <u>Challenge court play sessions</u>, open to all members, are scheduled on Tues/Thurs/Sat, 10:00am-12:00pm on five courts.
- Ball machine sessions are Tues/Sat, 10:00am-12:00pm. Each two-hour session is divided into three (3) 40-minute segments each of which is limited to two members.

Once the weather warms, we will move start times to 9:00am. You can review the playing schedule on our <u>website</u> and visit <u>CourtReserve</u> to book your play.

No RR sessions can occur without captains. We need volunteer captains to sign up or that day's RR will be cancelled. If you are interested in becoming a RR captain, <u>email us</u>, text 541-233-3978, or talk with a captain/ball machine operator on the courts at Pine Nursery Park.

Our schedule for ball machines is included in the playing schedule. As with RR sessions, ball machine sessions cannot occur without an operator present. Please contact <u>Dean Guyer</u> to arrange for training on the machines.
