

Bend Pickleball Club Code of Conduct

Pursuant to Bend Pickleball Club Bylaws, Article III Section C, the Board of Directors has adopted the following Code of Conduct effective 1/4/2024 and applicable to all members. Violations may result in corrective action up to and including termination of membership.

Bend Pickleball Club Code of Conduct

I will treat others with dignity, cordiality, and respect.

I will exhibit fairness and honesty in my dealings with others.

I will accept responsibility for my own actions.

I will follow Bend Pickleball Club rules governing court management and organized play.

I will support Bend Pickleball Club policies, procedures, plans and initiatives.

I will not use Bend Pickleball Club records or materials for personal gain.

I will not engage in any behavior that would endanger the health, safety, or wellbeing of others.

I will not engage in the use of vulgar, coarse, or profane language or gestures.

I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct or encourage others to do so.

I will exemplify the highest standard in ethical behavior and fair play.

I will engage in conduct that is free from fear, discrimination, abuse, and harassment.

I will comply with [Bend Park and Recreation District \(BPRD\) Rules and Regulations](#) (incorporated by reference) when participating in Club activities at BPRD facilities.

Where the conduct violates any law, the appropriate law enforcement jurisdiction should be notified immediately.

Wherever possible, disputes and complaints should be resolved amicably and at the lowest possible level. Where conduct violations are otherwise so egregious or recurring that they necessitate Board action, the complaint should be brought to the attention of any Board member.

A Board member receiving a complaint will bring the matter to the attention of the President who will confer with the Board and make a determination as to how to proceed.

By joining the Club or renewing membership, members acknowledge having read and agreed to comply with the Code of Conduct. Corrective or punitive action for violations may include but are not limited to the following:

- Suspension of violator's access to Club courts or activities
- Termination of Club membership
