- This Hawaiian-themed dinner is strictly for registrants and, if desired, one paid dinner guest
- Beverages include soft drinks and water. BYOB!

Tournament Play – Saturday, June 21, 7:30am player check-In

- Tournament play begins at 8:30am
- Match finals should be completed before 5:00pm. Please plan to stay for the entire day!

Where: Pine Nursery Park, Yeoman Street entrance, Bend

Details

- Entry fee \$49. Fee covers the facility rental and catered dinner.
- Registrants are <u>required</u> to attend BOTH events, no exceptions.
- Each registrant may include a dinner guest for \$49.
- Payment(s) due with registration beginning at 8:00am, March 15, on CourtReserve
- 96 player limit

Player Groupings and Teams

All skill levels are approximate. Actual Group composition will depend upon the skill levels of all registered players. Numbers are based on a complete roster of 96 registrants.

- 1. INDIVIDUAL (96 max) registers on CourtReserve; skill level is known.
- 2. PAIRS/PARTNERS (48) Tournament staff randomly pairs the Individual with a same-level partner. These two players remain a Pair throughout the tournament. Pairs will be "revealed" at the dinner.
- 3. GROUPS (16 Pairs x 3 levels) Pairs from each of the 3 skill levels, again randomly chosen, constitute a Group.
 - A Groups = 2.5-3.0 = 32 players
 - B Groups = 3.5-4.0 = 32 players
 - C Groups = 4.5 + = 32 players

Players play only against Pairs within their skill group.

- 4. TEAMS (16 total) One set of A, B, and C Group pairings, together, comprise a Team of 6 players. Teams will be "revealed" at the dinner.
- 5. DIVISIONS (2) –8 Teams comprise each Division: Mt. Bachelor Division and Broken Top Division

Play Format

- Every Pair on a Team plays 7 matches against other Team Pairs of the same Group level.
- Every match is 16 minutes max, using rally scoring. Pairs switch sides at score of 6 points. One time out per team. First Team Pair to score 11 wins the match.
- Tournament ends with a final match between #1 Teams from each Division.
- Tie breakers: USAPickleball rules will apply.

The Auction

Auction bidding is optional. Players are not required to bid.

Money split: 50% of all funds generated will go to BPC funding for Courts.

- 50% of group pot to owner of highest point pair in Group.
- 30% of group pot to owner of second highest point pair in Group.
- 20% of group pot to owner of third highest point pair in group.
- 50% of team pot to 1st place team owner.
- 30% of team pot to 2nd place team owner.
- 20% of team pot to 3rd place team owner.

Registration

- Online registration and payments only!

- Registrant entry fee is due with registration and includes dinner.
- Registrant may opt to pay \$49 for one "dinner only" guest.
- Registration opens 8:00am, March 15, and closes June 5 or when full.

Cancellations/Refunds

- No refunds after June 1.
- Any cancellations after June 15 will result in Team forfeiture.
- No player substitutions are allowed for any reason after Teams have been announced.
